WHY NON-CATHOLICS CANNOT RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION?

This is a question that is often asked. In the Catholic Church, we believe the reception of Holy Communion is the sign and symbol of union — union between Christ and those who receive Him, and union between all those who receive Christ in this sacrament. When you receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church, you are saying with your body and mind that you are in union, in belief and doctrine, with the Catholic Church. This is not just in regard to believing in Jesus and the Real Presence in Holy Communion, but also in regard to the Pope, to Mary, to the other Sacraments, to the Communion of Saints, the priesthood, salvation, and all the teachings of the Catholic Church. It's not a matter of "looking down" or "excluding" others but to be in communion is not merely just in spirit but also doctrinally which we express in partaking in Holy Communion. This is the public expression of our communion, spiritually and doctrinally, with the Catholic Church.
