RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

During the Season of Lent, candidates preparing to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter this year will commit themselves in stages as they participate in the different rites at mass. This Sunday, they will be presented to the Archbishop at the Rite of Election at the Church of Holy Family, Kajang @ 3:00 pm. Please keep them in prayer.

THE FOUR PILLARS OF LENT

Prayer: Try to pray a little more often, visit the church daily for personal prayer. During Lent, the Stations of the Cross (prayers about the journey Jesus made to his crucifixion on Good Friday) we should make an effort to attend. This is a powerful way to contemplate, and enter into, the mystery of Jesus' gift of himself to us.

Abstinence: To abstain means to go without something; try to abstain from the internet or your mobile devices. Other forms of abstinence like from meat, alcohol, etc., may also help us to be more aware of the season and on the passion and death of Jesus on the Cross.

Fasting: To fast, we go without food or eat less. It can also mean giving up certain foods or treats. Perhaps on certain days you restrict yourself only one full meal or two smaller meals or give up snacking between meals or a favourite food.

Almsgiving: Do good things for others. For example, this can be giving gifts of food / money or help to others. Think about sharing your time, talent and treasure with those in need or any social organisation. Perhaps to visit the sick, the elderly, the lonely, etc. What can you do to help others?
